WHEREAS, sexual violence undermines the values and safety of Nevada communities; and

WHEREAS, the Silver State is committed to engaging new voices to speak up and speak out against sexual violence, with the common goal of expanding sexual assault prevention efforts to ensure the next generation fosters attitudes that promote healthy relationships, equality, and respect:
