KEY POINTS:

- The proposed \$25 increase to the marriage license fee will secure a much-needed increase in the only state funding for domestic violence programs. It will also create the first ever funding to be distributed statewide for sexual violence programs
- Without this funding, advocacy programs will not be able to expand their lifesaving services, which include: shelter; advocacy with law enforcement, hospitals, and the courts; trauma recovery support groups and more.
- Over the past five years, there has been a steady increase in the reported rapes and domestic violence offenses to law enforcement in Nevada.
 - From 2017 to 2018, law enforcement saw a 24.34% increase in the number of reported rapes.
 - From the years 2015 to 2017, there was ~1.5% increase each year in the number of reported domestic violence cases.

We know that for every reported number to law enforcement there are a handful of victim-survivors not reporting but seeking the lifesaving services of advocacy organizations.
