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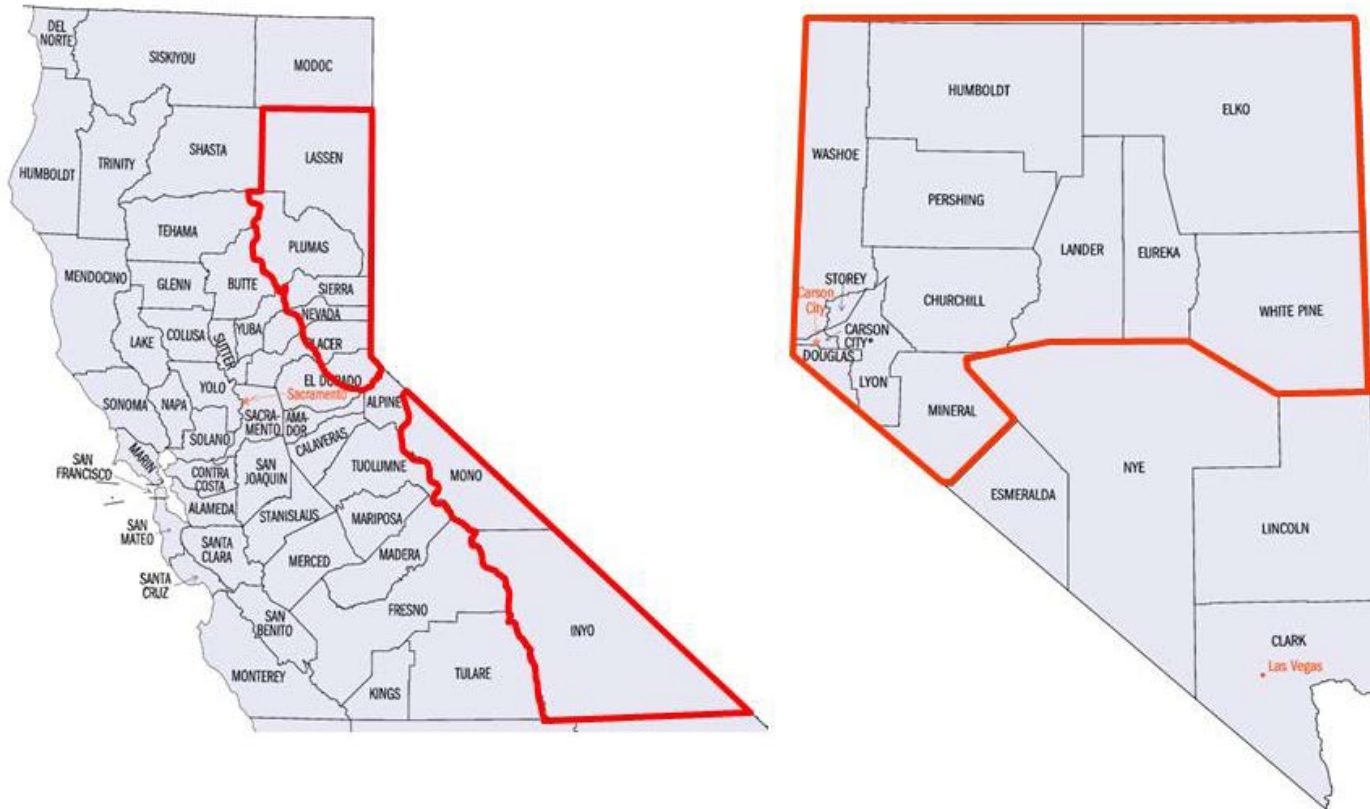

- **Our Vision:** Healthy Food. Every Person. Every Day.

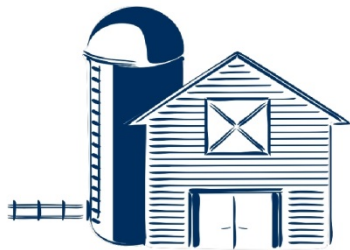
Where We Operate

HOW WE FEED NEIGHBORS IN NEED



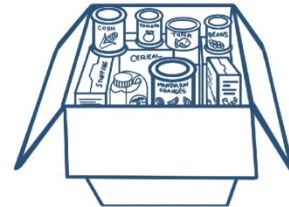
FOOD DONORS & SOURCES

The Food Bank of Northern Nevada receives food from grocers, manufacturers, farmers, food drives, and more.



FOOD BANK OF NORTHERN NEVADA

Annually, the Food Bank distributes enough food for more than 15.3 million meals, ensuring food safety throughout the entire process.



PARTNER AGENCIES & DIRECT SERVICE PROGRAMS

Food is distributed in our community through food pantries, soup kitchens, shelters, and Food Bank programs.



NEIGHBORS STRUGGLING WITH HUNGER

Children, families, and seniors have access to the food they need.

Using a network of 140 partner agencies

Agency Partners

- What They Do . . .
 - Operate Food Pantries/Soup Kitchens/Shelters/Residential Treatment Programs/Transitional Housing Programs/Youth & Teen Programs/Child Care Centers/Senior Centers
 - Operate Summer Food Outlets & BP Program



Mobile Harvest

- Visits neighborhoods across Northern Nevada and Eastern California to distribute produce and other fresh food items to clients.
- No income requirements.



Child Nutrition Programs

- Kids Cafe – Summer and after school meals for children 1 – 18
- School Pantry Program
- Back-Pack Kids



SNAP Outreach

- In partnership with DWSS, FBNN's SNAP Team visits neighborhoods across Northern Nevada to assist with SNAP and Medicaid applications.
- FBNN's team assists with the application, document submission, and required interview.



SNAP Call Center

- FBNN's SNAP Team assists clients with SNAP applications over the phone.
- Call 775-331-3663 X 152 and leave a message for assistance.



Senior Boxes (CSFP)

- The Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP) provides a monthly box of nutritious food to low-income seniors 60 years and over.
- Income based requirements.
- Boxes are distributed at more than 40 locations across Reno, Sparks, and rural northern Nevada.
- Box options for seniors that don't qualify for CSFP.



Produce on Wheels

- The produce on wheels program focuses on providing seniors, aged 60 years and over, with access to fresh, nutritious foods.
- No income requirements.



Nutrition Education

- Direct Education Classes
 - Smart Shopper
 - Seniors Eating Well
- Nutrition on Wheels (NOW)
 - At Mobile Harvest and Produce on Wheels
- Healthy Pantry Initiative
 - 18 partner agencies
