

# In-Person Expedited Training

## The Sexual Assault Response Team

is seeking already trained and seasoned advocates to volunteer to provide advocacy to survivors of recent sexual assault at their Sexual Assault Forensic Exam (SAFE).

### Who are we looking for?

Currently trained advocates who are:

- Comfortable with in-person advocacy OR are willing to apply their advocacy skills to an in-person setting.
- Have at least 6 months of advocacy experience.
- Willing to learn about the SART process and take 1-2 On-Call shifts per month (or more if willing).



### SART On-Call Shifts

- SART Shifts run for 12 hours starting/ending at 6 AM or 6 PM.
- SART Advocates take 1-2 shifts per month (or more if willing).
  - o Day Shifts are during the day from 6 AM – 6 PM
  - o Night Shifts are overnight from 6 PM – 6 AM

### Expedited Training Process


1. A 1-day In-Person Training at the CAC ~4 hours
  - a. SART Exam Protocol– learning about what a SAFE exam looks like and your role as the advocate during their exam and interacting with the Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner (SANE)
  - b. Tour of the CAC - learning the various rooms of the CAC and where to find everything you need to support the survivor.
2. 3 Shadow Exams with a current SART Advocate
