WHAT IS NEVADA S.A.V.E. NOTIFICATIONS?

Nevada S.A.V.E. is the new victim notification system for survivors, advocates, victims and enforcement.



OUR MISSION

Empowering victims with greater control over notification decisions. Enhancing victim services through comprehensive offender tracking.



OUT OF CUSTODY OFFENDERS

Offenders who are no longer in custody might not appear in search results. If you signed up for alerts about an offender who is no longer in custody, you will get notifications if they return to custody. If that offender returns to custody, you will be notified via your preferred contact methods and your registration will be updated to show the offender's changed status.



HOW DOES NV S.A.V.E NOTIFICATIONS WORK?

Nevada S.A.V.E Notifications provides a web portal to search for offenders in custody using a web enabled device. Users may explore certain features, including a basic offender search, without an account. To access the full suite of features, registration is required.

Nevada S.A.V.E. Notifications is designed to ensure victims only have to register once to receive consistent and reliable notifications

How To Register For Notifications:

1. To register, go to the NV.SAVE.GOV and create an account.
2. Enter the name of the person in custody you want to receive notification on.
3. Select the type of notification you want to receive and the frequency.
