


2025 DOMESTIC VIOLENCE HOMICIDE REPORT


LIVES LOST DUE TO HOMICIDE

GENDER BREAKDOWN OF LIVES LOST





- There were three incidents where a perpetrator was killed by law enforcement's use of deadly force when responding to a domestic violence call. These numbers were not included in the final number.
- There were 10 attempted murders, but due to various interventions the victims lived.


There was one attempted murder suicide in which the victim died, but the perpetrator survived their suicide attempt. The death of the victim was included in the final number.

HOMICIDES BY MONTH




MEANS OF DEATH

In one incident, a perpetrator stabbed the victim who ultimately lived, but then the perpetrator took their own life in a barricade. The perpetrator's life was included in the total number of lives lost.


AGE OF VICTIMS*

HOMICIDES BY COUNTY




METHODOLOGY

NCEDSV’s Domestic Violence Homicide Report is compiled using publicly available resources and archives. Knowing that domestic violence is nuanced and not every incident is publicized, we recognize that there may be deaths not accounted for in this report.

Homicide incidents used in this report were determined by NRS 33.018, with a focus on domestic violence homicides that resulted from intimate-partner relationships, meaning that a romantic or dating relationship was present. An “incident” is defined as an occurrence of domestic violence that turned lethal, some of which resulted in multiple lives lost. It should be noted that in 2025 there were 10 tragic domestic violence homicides that occurred between family members. Those lives lost were not included in the final numbers.

RELATIONSHIP DYNAMICS



*Romantic Rival refers to the new partner of the primary victim that had a previous personal relationship with the perpetrator.

**Publicly available data often does not list this information.

One incident involved an intentional, reckless-driving homicide in which the perpetrator drove his pregnant partner at speeds of up to 100 mph in a 45-mph zone, causing a 12-car pileup that resulted in the deaths of the pregnant partner, their unborn child, and another driver. The perpetrator survived.
